As a TAH grant partner, Dominican University's Ukiah Center will accept 12 units from the Sonoma State University School of Extended Education offered for your participation in the three summer institutes. Dominican will provide 18 units of master's degree core classes, for the completion of a 30-unit master's degree in education.*

Six courses will be scheduled on selected Saturdays, and will include an online and web-enhanced format. A special tuition rate will be available for TAH participants only. Financial aid is also available for qualified applicants.
